FROM THE School Administrator...

Greetings! Thank you to all of the parents that went along on Outdoor Education Day! The students had a great day. We are very thankful for the beautiful weather. Pictures from the day will be on our Facebook page.

MAP testing begins next week. Teachers will provide more information about exact days each class will test. I am attaching an informational sheet that explains more about MAP testing.

If your child will be absent from school (or late to school; leave during the school day; leave early), please email school.office@zionmayer.org to let us know. If the absence is a result of illness, please also email the nurse at nurse@zionmayer.org.

Next Friday, Sept. 24th is our Walk-A-Thon day. The day will start at St. Mark Lutheran Church in New Germany with Chapel at 8:30. **Please remember to drop off your child(ren) at St. Mark between 8:10 and 8:20.** Please pray for good weather! Students will need a **bag lunch with a drink** and should wear their **Gentleness** tshirt. We plan to depart for Mayer starting around 9:15, eat around 11:00, and the day will end after the Amazing Race around 1:30. **Students should be picked up at 1:30 at Zion. There is NO afterschool Extended Care.**

The Walk-A-Thon is our main PTL fundraiser. Our goal is that each family would raise a minimum of \$250. This would allow us to reach our school goal of \$21,000. We are not asking that each family donate the money themselves, but reach out to friends, family, and neighbors to ask for their support. Unlike other fundraisers where selling items earn a small 20-30% profit for the school, the Walk-A-Thon allows 100% of the profits to be put directly into the school's PTL budget for the school year to benefit ALL students – preschool to 8th grade. The PTL budget

helps purchase items for the school AND keeps tuition down.

The first opportunity our choirs have to sing in church is Sunday, Oct. 3 at 8:00 am at Zion when our 1st-4th grade students will sing. This is an opportunity for our students to show their appreciation to the congregation for the financial support that they give. Zion Lutheran Church contributes approximately half the cost per student for their education. We encourage all 1st-4th grade students to attend that Sunday. I am attaching a choir schedule that has all of the dates that the choirs will sing this school year.

Please save the date: Grandparents Day is Friday, Oct. 29th. More information will follow in the next few weeks.

I will be out of the office Monday afternoon through Wednesday next week attending the Minnesota Independent School Forum conference. If you need immediate assistance, please contact the office.
