

### **Build A Birdhouse**

Forget about winter for a while and get ready for Spring!

Wrens are tiny birds that are welcome neighbors in any neighborhood or yard with their songs and appetite for mosquitoes. The Zion Men's Workshop invites you to join in the fun and build a wren house.



Building these clever little houses is easy and a good introduction to some very basic woodworking techniques. They can later be decorated and provide entertainment and interest when the wrens return in the Spring.

This activity will be held in two afternoon sessions, the first on Saturday, January 22 and again on Sunday, January 23, both starting at 1 p.m., in the Men's Workshop in Zion's basement. We welcome youth and adults. Youth aged 5-13, are to be accompanied by a responsible adult. No experience is required, and tool use will be supervised. Materials and the use of safety glasses will be provided as well as a dimension drawing and a ruler you may keep.
