## **Preparing Ourselves for Lent**

There is no denying that Winter is here. The snow that came down on January 23rd and 24th and the cold temps that dipped to near zero, with wind chills in the minus teens, have announced through these signs that Winter has come. No one in Ohio doubts it.

I wish everyone in Israel had recognized the signs of the coming Messiah so that there had been no doubt when Jesus read from the scroll in the synagogue in Nazareth. So that we could all rejoicing with one another that our sins are forgiven and that the promise of eternal life has been extended to us by God's grace.

Oh, wait, we still can rejoice over that, because even as blind as we in this world might be, the church still sheds the gospel light upon us, calling us into worship and study and teaching and prayer, and most especially, into the promises the sacraments, of forgiven sins and life eternal.

The gospel calls us to all of this because without it we would be lost in our sins whose consequence is condemnation and death. All of us are sinners and all of us are in need of forgiveness. This comes to us in an attitude of repentance – the recognition of our need for God's help and grace. So, for our midweek Lenten worship we will be centered on the theme or repentance. The theme is called 'Return to the Lord' and is taken from Joel 2:13 – "Return to the LORD your God, for He is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love; and He relents over disaster."

God's invitation for us to return to him, and promise of his grace, mercy, patience and steadfast love, finds its fullness in Jesus Christ. Following different events during our Lord's Passion we will focus on the people that followed Jesus to see how God calls his people to return to him. 

### **New Projects**

The trustees have been looking into several major projects for the church. Next year (2023) will be the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the sanctuary being built. The trustees would like to complete these projects for our 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration.

New carpet is needed in the sanctuary as the foam backing is deteriorating and the carpet is stretched out. This is an expensive project since the pews need to be removed to complete the work and the old carpet needs to be removed which is glued to the cement flooring.

The education building needs new drapes because the old drapes are over forty years old, stained, and have deteriorating linings. The trustees would like to have the drapes custom made, if possible; the drapes have to be made of fire retardant material since they are for a commercial building.

The last project is updating the kitchen to provide more storage, a new sink, and upgrading the electrical breakers, so they would not be so easily tripped.

Several of these projects are expensive and will be presented at one or two congregational meetings to be approved once all the figures are in. Interest made from the Trust last year would help pay for these projects. In the meantime, if any member would like to give to any of these projects through memorials or donations, there are funds set up for carpet, drapes, and kitchen. Let the office know which fund you would like your donation to go towards.
