



NICENE CREED

ROOF MORTGAGE LOAN BURNING


P: At this time, we remember that on October 2nd, 2014, this Congregation, Zion Lutheran Church St Marys OH, took out a real estate mortgage and security agreement with Thrivent Financial for Lutherans of Wisconsin, to pay for a new roof for our entire facility in the amount of \$214,000.

We did so trusting in Christ Jesus, our Lord and Savior, to provide for us the means to pay it off by October 15, 2029. As St Paul wrote in his letter to the Philippians:

- C: "And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus."
- P: In the Lord's gracious abundance, freely given to the people of Zion Lutheran Church St Marys OH, we joyfully proclaim the entirety of the mortgage loan paid off as of December 15, 2021. This is eight (8) years earlier than required.
- C: "And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus."
- P: We give thanks and praise of Christ Jesus our Lord for providing for our needs with such generosity that the mortgage loan could be paid so quickly, and our debt be discharged so soon.
- C: As the Psalmist says: "I will give thanks to you, Lord, with all my heart; I will tell of all your wonderful deeds." Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised!
- P: It is with great joy that we burn the Roof Mortgage Loan Documents in public acknowledgement that the Loan is no more. (set fire to the documents when fire is out the Ushers will remove the portable Fire from the Sanctuary.)

- C: and shall declare your mighty acts.




PREFACE


