

OCC Shoebox Information:

Why do we pack Shoeboxes?

We know that we are commanded in Matthew 28 to "make disciples of all nations" and that may seem overwhelming to us individually. When we pack shoebox gifts, we give Samaritans Purse opportunities to share the hope of the Gospel.

In eastern Ukraine, one of our church partners received over 400 refugees from towns under attack. Among them were some refugees from Afghanistan who had previously fled to Ukraine to escape the fighting in their homeland. The local pastor gave shoebox gifts to the children and with their father's permission, shared the Gospel message. The Afghan family later relocated to Germany. The pastor was thankful to have this opportunity to plant seeds for the Gospel and is praying that the gifts will bear the fruit of salvation in Christ.

Thank you for packing boxes. Please continue to pray for each child who will eventually receive our boxes and know that each box has the potential to have an eternal impact.
