I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.





OCC Shoebox Information:

Why do we pack Shoeboxes?

We know that we are commanded in Matthew 28 to "make disciples of all nations" and that may seem overwhelming to us individually. When we pack shoebox gifts, we give Samaritans Purse opportunities to share the hope of the Gospel.

In Moldova, one of the countries that welcomed Ukrainian refugees, the Lord used shoebox gifts to revive a small church. The congregation had dwindled to just a few elderly adults with no children. Then the church invited 150 boys and girls from the town to receive shoebox gifts, presented the gospel to them and invited the children to participate in The Greatest Journey discipleship lessons. Dozens of children and their parents began coming to the church and a new Sunday school was started. "The word of God grew and multiplied" (Acts 12:24).

Thank you for packing boxes. Please continue to pray for each child who will eventually receive our boxes and know that each box has the potential to have an eternal impact.

Boxes are due back today.

Zion Women's Thankful Offering Services will be **today**, and **Wednesday**, **November 16**. All donations will go to Crime Victims Services in Lima, Ohio. Please bring your donation in an envelope and keep the container to re-use for next year. We will collect the envelopes at each service.

The Underground will meet on Sunday, November 20, at 7 p.m.

A Community Thanksgiving Service will be held on Tuesday, November 22, at 6 p.m., at the St. Marys Theater.

Our Thanksgiving Eve Worship Service will be on Wednesday, November 23, at 7 p.m., in the sanctuary, with holy communion being served. The canned goods we collect, and the loose offering are earmarked for Auglaize County Crisis Center. Please bring your donations to the church at our Thanksgiving Eve Service or it can be dropped off in the tub beforehand. Donated items will be delivered to ACCC after Thanksgiving. The items needed: canned fruit, Jello, Hamburger Helper, taco kits, canned beans, soup, cereal, breakfast bars, any type of snack food (cookies, chips, etc.), juice, paper towels, laundry soap, and trash bags.

The church office will be closed on Thursday, November 24, and Friday, November 25, in observance of Thanksgiving.

The Giving Thanks meal will be offered from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m., on Thursday, November 24, at the High School, for families that would not have a good Thanksgiving meal or may not have anyone to celebrate with on that day. They can come together for good food, fellowship, and give thanks to God with friends in the community. Churches are being asked to donate pies for the meal. The pies can be dropped off at the Wayne Street United Church, Wednesday, November 23, from 1-4 p.m., or at the High School (at the door south of the commons area), from 5-7 p.m.
