



The total receipts for Zion Lutheran Church in 1916 were \$ 2,206.67. Total expenses were \$2,169.35. The Pastors' salary of \$1,200 and wages for the organist- \$147 and janitor- \$166 were the main outlays. Coal to heat the buildings cost \$73.79 and updates to the parsonage were other notable expenses.
