What does the Holy Spirit do for you? In this third part of our series, we'll focus on how the Spirit "enlightens" us.

The Holy Spirit, as noted previously, gathers us together into the Church. Within this Church, the Spirit now works to enlighten us, in the sense of giving us wisdom in our faith. The Spirit works among us to bring wisdom in a variety of ways, including:

- A) Continuing to point us to the light of Jesus. Jesus taught us that He is the light of the world. At Zion, we have two windows at the front of our worship space (where the light of Christ literally shines through) that portray the stories of cross and resurrection, constantly reminding us that Jesus is the center of our faith.
- B) Providing us the Holy Scriptures. The Bible teaches us that "all scripture is inspired by God" (2 Timothy 3:16). This means that every single person who helped write the Bible was being guided by the Holy Spirit. The Bible stands apart from every other book ever written, because of the inspiration of the Spirit. Now as we read these divinely-inspired Words, the Spirit guides us in our own reading and understanding, so that we too are inspired by God through these scriptures.
- C) Providing, through the Church, opportunities to learn and grow in faith. We learn together. We study together. Together, members of denominations have developed systems to write and publish curriculums for Sunday School and Confirmation and Vacation Bible School, and the Spirit now works through each of those ministries to shine the light of Jesus in our lives.
- D) Guiding our daily decisions. Because we have studied these scriptures provided through the Spirit, we are wise to live our lives in the light of the gospel. And when we face particularly difficult decisions in life, we can draw on the wisdom of other Christians (through the Church that the Spirit has gathered), and we can pray directly to Father, Son, and Spirit for personal guidance to make God-honoring decisions.

What an incredible blessing it is, that God has given us the Holy Spirit to enlighten us!




August Loose Offering




