PRAYER TOPICS

1. Pray for Ordained Leadership and Staff

Pray with thanksgiving for all that God has done to provide Zion with professional leaders and staff who seek to use their God given talents and gifts at Zion, as God has called them.

2. Pray for Zion's Faithfulness as a Congregation

Thank God for the blessings Zion has already received over these past 163 years, and for the love and grace God has showered upon Zion through our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

Pray that God would continue to bless Zion so that it may grow in number, in resources, and in it's desire to Teach, Preach the gospel, and Reach those who are lost, hurt or seeking the truth.

Pray that the Holy Spirit stirs our membership - each member, each household - to share the gospel with others with courage and conviction. That each member, and each household, speak to lapsed and wayward family members, and unchurched community members with a sense of compassion remembering to invite those family and community members to worship, to Bible studies, to Vacation Bible School, to Confirmation classes, to the Underground, and to Sunday school.

Pray that the Holy Spirit would stir the hearts of those who have been absent from worship and fellowship events at Zion, and lead them back to regular worship and back to attending fellowship events.

5. Pray for a Protective Hedge for Zion

Thank God for the blessing of 163 years of ministry as a congregation. Pray for healing within the membership and for a deep unity to develop within the membership of the congregation. Help us to truly see each member as a brother or sister - as family connected through the blood of Christ to one another.
