Story

The Fall into Sin—Genesis 3

Adam and Eve were not supposed to eat from **the tree of the knowledge of Good and Evil**. When Adam and Eve ate from the forbidden tree, **the tree of the knowledge of Good and Evil**, they knew they had sinned. For this reason, Adam and Eve **tried to hide from God**. Adam and Eve were tempted to sin by the serpent. The serpent that tempted Eve is **Satan**, his name means “adversary.” **Satan is a fallen angel**. He rebelled against God at some point in time before tempting Adam and Eve to sin.

Glossary

the tree of the knowledge of good and evil The object in the Garden of Eden to which God attached His word of curse: if man did not listen to God's Word and ate of its fruit, sin would be born and man would die.

The tree of life The object in the Garden of Eden to which God attached His word of promise: if man ate of its fruit he would live forever.

Satan The head of the fallen angels. He rebelled against God and wants to be God himself. He is a liar and murderer from the beginning of creation and opposes all that is good. He is the serpent that deceived Adam and Eve. He is anti-God and anti-Christ, the ruler, or prince, of this world, and the enemy of the Church. He desires to bring to ruin the faith of every Christian and to drive people away from the true God in any way that he can. Genesis 3:15 predicts his defeat.

The Fall Name given to the first sin of disobeying God's Law that said to not eat of the fruit of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. After this sin, Adam and Eve hid from God. Because God still loved them He promised to send a Seed (Son) to Eve that would crush Satan. [Genesis 3]

the Torah The first five books of the Bible written by the prophet Moses. They are the foundation for all the Scripture. They are also called "the Law" or "the Law of Moses."

the historical books The twelve Old Testament books after the Torah which record the history of God's chosen people Israel.
