THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

SAY THE APOSTLE'S CREED

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth.

And in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried. He descended into hell. Glossary

Cain The first-born son of Adam and Eve. Eve thought he was “the promised Seed” sent from God to be the Savior (Gen. 3:15 and 4:1). He was a tiller of the ground and murdered his brother out of hateful jealousy.

Abel The second-born son of Adam and Eve. He was a keeper of sheep and a man of faith in God. He was murdered by his jealous brother when his offering was received by the Lord and his brother’s offering was rejected.

Seth The third-born son of Adam and Eve. He continued the genealogy of the Messiah by taking the place of his murdered brother.
