Story

God Makes All Things – Genesis 1:1-2:25

THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

SAY THE APOSTLE'S CREED

Glossary

Noah The man who believed in God, built the ark, and became the father of the human race after the flood. He and his family were the only “righteous ones” on earth, because they trusted the Lord and relied on His mercy.

The flood The water that God sent upon the earth, because of the wickedness of man, to bring death and destruction upon mankind and all living things. This deluge of water corresponds to the saving water of Baptism which drowns the Old Adam and washes away sin.

Shem, Ham, and Japheth The three sons of Noah. They shared their father’s faith, helped him build the ark, and fathered the nations of the earth after the flood.

The ark The boat that God instructed Noah to build to bring his family and the animals of the earth to safety through the flood.

The rainbow The sign to which God has attached His promise that He will never again destroy the earth with a flood, but that the earth will continue to have her cycle of seasons, including planting and harvesting, until the Lord returns.
