Story

Joseph’s Dreams–Genesis 37

Joseph was **hated** by his brothers because Israel loved Joseph more. Joseph had dreams that foretold that he would be over all his family and that they would **bow down** to him. Joseph’s brothers were **jealous** and wanted to **kill** him. Reuben made **intercession** for Joseph in order to save him from being killed. Instead of killing Joseph, his brothers took his **robe**, threw him into a **pit**, and sold him into **slavery** to **Ishmaelites**. The **Ishmaelites** took Joseph to **Egypt**.

Glossary

Israel The name that means “he struggles with God.” God gave this name to Jacob, and it became the name of the chosen Old Testament nation that descended from Abraham. The Church of true believers in Christ bears this Old Testament name today.

Joseph The favorite son of Jacob. He was sold by his jealous brothers to Ishmaelite traders and taken to Egypt where he eventually became a prince. Years later he befriended his brothers, forgave them their sin, and brought the entire family into Egypt to live in the land of Goshen.

Reuben The first-born son of Jacob and Leah who interceded for Joseph so that his other brothers wouldn’t kill him.

Egypt The country in Africa in which the Old Testament nation of Israel was in bondage for over four hundred years.

Intercession This is a word used in the Scriptures for prayer or making requests to someone for someone else. Jesus makes intercession for us before the Father in heaven. Reuben made intercession before his brothers so that they wouldn’t kill Joseph.
