Story

Joseph in Egypt—Genesis 39-41

Potiphar, an officer of **Pharaoh**, bought Joseph and put him in charge of all that he had. **Potiphar’s wife** lied about Joseph. **Potiphar believed her** and **put Joseph into prison**. Joseph was released from prison and **given command over all of Pharaoh’s people** because **God gave Joseph understanding to interpret the dreams of Pharaoh**. **God used Joseph to feed the people of all the earth** during the seven year **famine** revealed in Pharaoh’s dreams.

Did You Know?

Pharaoh is an Egyptian royal title meaning “the great house.” It originally applied to the king’s palace, but was later applied to rulers of Egypt.

Joseph was seventeen years old when sold into slavery, around twenty-eight when he interpreted the dreams of the cupbearer and baker, and thirty when freed from jail.

Joseph became the highest ranking official, master in the royal palace and also throughout Egypt. However, supreme authority remained with Pharaoh.
