Did You Know?

John wrote Revelation using an approach called “apocalyptic” style. The word *apocalypse* means “unveiling” or “revealing.”

Scripture repeatedly underscores that one of the greatest blessings of the new heavens and new earth is that restored mankind will again behold God face-to-face and live in His immediate presence.

The new creation has already begun to appear through the preaching of the Gospel and the work of the Spirit. However, it will not be completed until the day of Christ’s return.
